**NOTICE TO THE MARKET**

Rio de Janeiro, August 04, 2016 - Equatorial Energia S.A. (BM&FBOVESPA: EQTL3) and Centrais Elétricas do Pará S.A. – CELPA informs the market that on August 02, ANEEL – Agência Nacional de Energia Elétrica (Brazilian Electric Energy Regulatory Agency) approved the annual tariff adjustment for CELPA.

The average Tariff Adjustment Index (IRT, in Portuguese) was established at 13.37% (economic adjustment), however, considering the net effect from the inclusion of the Financial Components, the adjustment to be perceived by the consumers will be 7.55%.

The Parcel B had an increase of 10.36%, influenced by the IGP-M of the reference period that was 11.63%, less the X Factor of 1.27%, being that the Q component of the X Factor of -0.44% that contributed positively in the results. Thus the Parcel B approved reached the amount of R \$ 1,607 million.

Regarding the adjustment of Parcel A, the Pmix of the Energy Purchase had an increase of 20.73%, resulting in the average cost of R\$ 173.52 per MWh. Noteworthy is the increase in the price of the quotas (70.36%) as one of the main reasons for this increase.

Additionally, the value of the monthly transfers to be made by Eletrobrás to CELPA were established at R\$ 8,323,359.35 relating to CDE Grant – Tariff Discount.

The final amount of the approved adjustment had an effect of the injunction contained in Case No. 44378-02.2016.4.01.3400 of the 3rd Federal Court, where ANEEL fulfilled the determination of justice to consider all CELPA's exposure in 2014 as involuntary, excluding any negative financial effect in the Company's Tariff Adjustment until the final decision of the process. The injunction obtained had the effect of preventing the classification of this exposure as volunteer.

The tariff adjustment will take effect as from August 07, 2016.
